LWML History Highlights of our Oklahoma District

Beginning in the 1850's, women of The Lutheran Church--Missouri Synod (LCMS) established auxiliaries to meet the needs of people. These were extraordinary women! They began by mending clothes for seminarians; they equipped hospitals, established schools, convalescent and retirement homes; assisted orphanages and residences for people with disabilities; gathered clothing, furniture and food for indigents; and eventually branched into funding mission endeavors at home and abroad. In the 1920's, women from independent LCMS churches coordinated their efforts by uniting in state and regional leagues. The first Lutheran Women's League (LWL) society was established at St. Peter's Lutheran Church in Apache, Oklahoma, in 1923. It would be 5 years later on March 11, 1928, for the very first district (Oklahoma) to be organized and a constitution adopted. In the coming weeks we will showcase more history of our Oklahoma District. Join us in gathering a special offering of mites with our 1928 replica of the first Mite Box. These boxes are on the table that has the giant Mite Box on it. Our district will be celebrating our 90th anniversary when we meet at convention on April 13-14, 2018, in Lawton.
