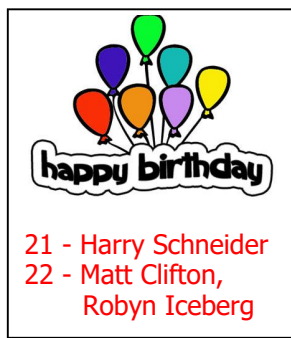

### LWML History Highlights of our Oklahoma District

At the 1938 LCMS Convention, Dr. Walter A. Maier spoke to the convention body, praising the women's efforts to organize a federation among the various district women's organizations. The Lutheran Women's League (LWL) President, Mrs. Clara Schmitt, from the Western District and Mrs. R. H. Meyer from St. Louis, appeared before the convention floor committee to plead the cause of womanhood. This was the FIRST time in LCMS history that women had the privilege of publicly speaking at a convention.
