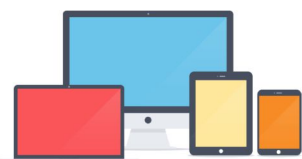

Canoes For Camp Lutherhaven

Your mite money goes to various missions that were selected at our LWML convention last April. We want to focus this month on our Mission Grant for 'Canoes for Lutherhaven Retreat Center' in Knowles, OK. Did you know that the LCMS owns two camps in the Oklahoma District? ... Lutherhoma in Tahlequah and Lutherhaven in Knowles. Lutherhaven is located in the western section of the Panhandle - in Beaver County. This retreat center is like Lutherhoma in that it provides individuals, families, churches, and circuits a place for meetings and recreation. The center sustained considerable damage to buildings and canoes in a grass fire that swept through the camp in March 2017. The insurance policy held by our LCMS Oklahoma District covered the two structures that were either damaged or destroyed but did not cover the boats that were destroyed. This Mission Grant of \$2,000 will help to purchase new canoes and we appreciate your donation to help with this mission grant. Donations are accepted throughout the month as well as the special 2nd Sunday of each month we call Mite Box Sunday which is coming up on July 8. Please put all mites inside the giant Mite Box. Thank you.
