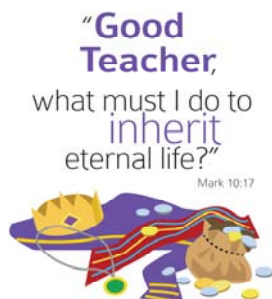


Twenty-first Sunday of Pentecost

INVOCATION
